Orange County Fair Wine Competition 2006 Silver Medal

The grapes for this wine come from a cooler part of Sonoma County – the confluence of the Alexander Valley and the Russian River Valley. The cooler climate here accentuates the bright, citrusy varietal characteristics while avoiding a grassy aroma. Pale straw in color, the wine has a floral nose with hints of guava. The wine has bright acidity, flavors of pears and citrus, and is crisp and full in the mouth.
